Boulder City residents only. By appointment only. Call 702.293.9256 Monday-Thursday 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. to make an appointment.

You must speak directly with a scheduler to secure an appointment.

Clinics will be held at the Elaine K. Smith Building, 700 Wyoming, and Boulder City Hospital, 901 Adams Blvd, in Boulder City

Starting January 25, 2021:

- Monday through Thursday, 8 a.m.-noon and 1 p.m.-3 p.m.
- People 70 years of age and older (required to show valid ID)
- Educators (required to show a valid school system ID)

- You will be required to stay at the clinic for at least 15 minutes after vaccine.
- Not available if you have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 90 days.
- Those without an appointment will be refused.
